

Using the Greater Lincolnshire Online Jobs & Careers Fair

1. **Check with your school:** get permission from your teachers before you use the site and follow all school safeguarding policy and procedures.
2. **Access the fair:** www.greaterlincsjobsfair.co.uk. Use Google Chrome for the best experience. You do not need to log in or create an account as a visitor. You can access the site at any time. Once a month the fair becomes live, meaning employers are active at their stands.
3. **Research exhibitors:** take a look at the [exhibition hall](#). Write down some facts about each of the businesses, colleges and support services.
4. **Research jobs and industries that interest you:** take time to think about your future, what careers do you find exciting?
5. **Visit the Main Stage:** here you will be able to [view talks](#) from employers and support services to give you some advice on your own career journey. Lots of speakers give tips on interview skills, CV writing and what they look for in employees.
