

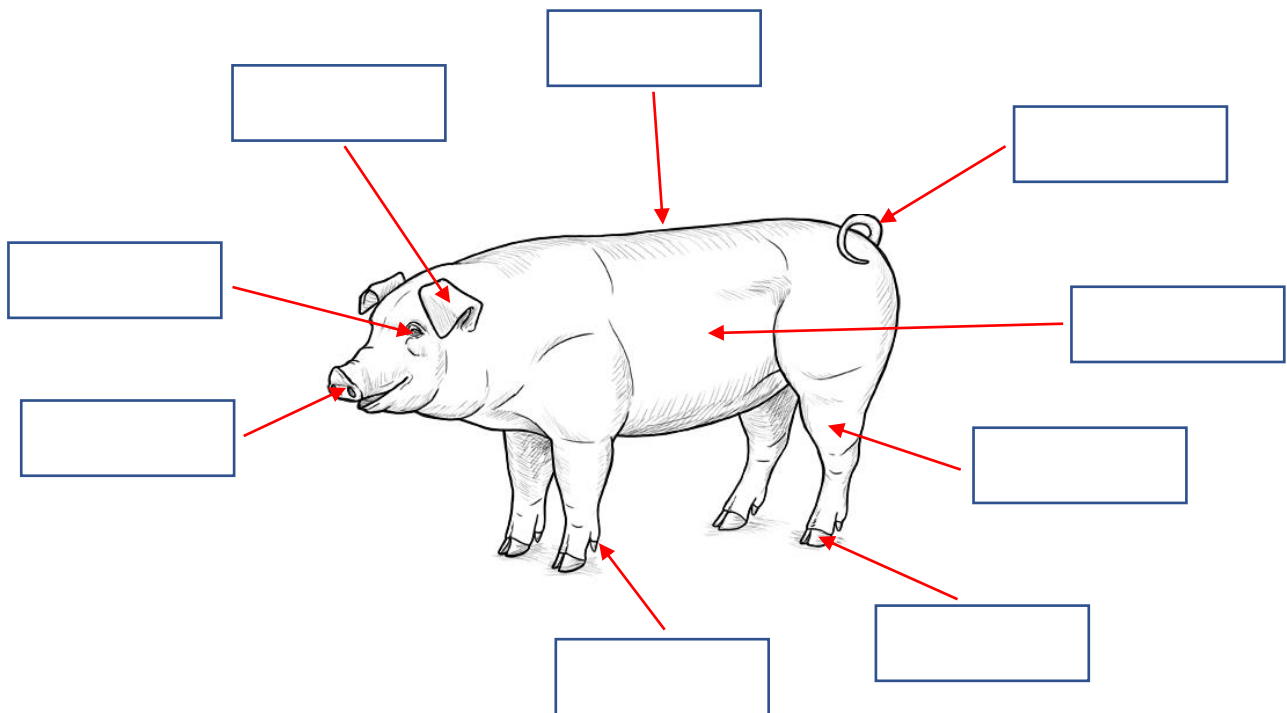
Lincolnshire Curly Coat Pig
