

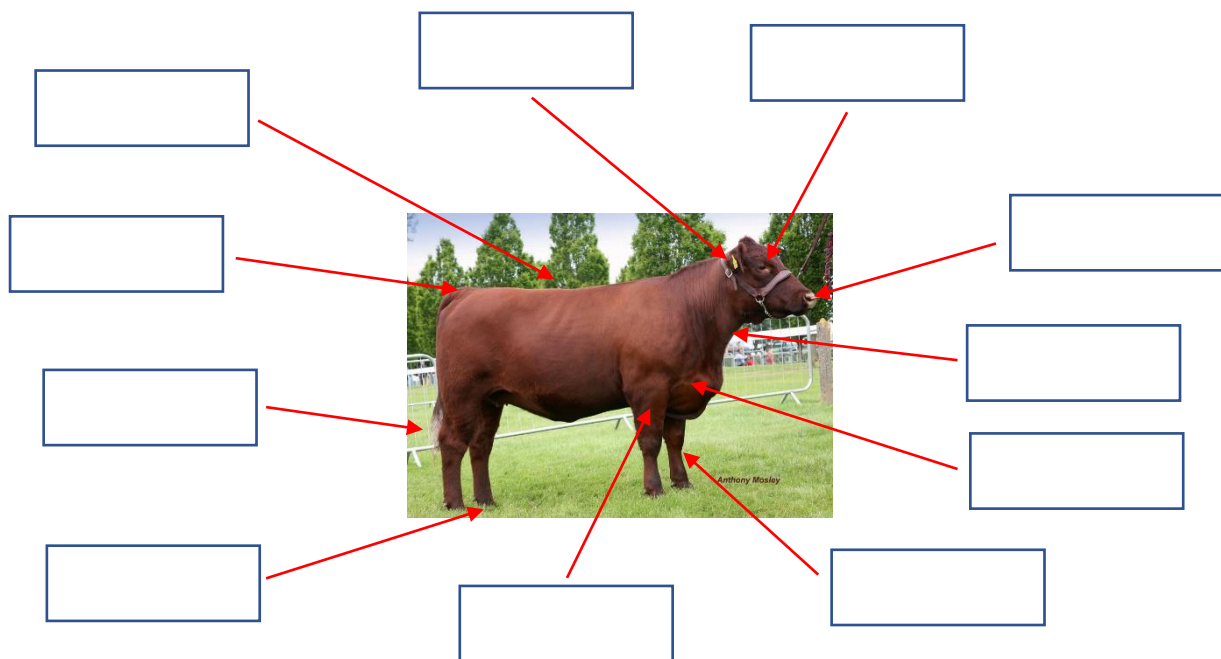
Lincoln Red Cattle
